

# **GAMBARAN TINGKAT KECEMASAN KELUARGA PASIEN YANG DI RAWAT DI RUANG ICU RUMAH SAKIT SUAKA INSAN BANJARMASIN 2024**

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## **ABSTRAK**

**Latar Belakang:** Kecemasan pada keluarga pasien di ruang ICU perlu menjadi perhatian perawat karena hal ini menyebabkan pengambilan keputusan yang kurang. Keluarga mempunyai peran penting dalam pengambilan keputusan secara langsung maupun tidak langsung dalam pertolongan, perawatan, dan pengobatan pasien. **Tujuan:** Menganalisis Tingkat Kecemasan Keluarga pasien yang anggota keluarganya dirawat di ruang ICU di Rumah Sakit Suaka Insan Banjarmasin. **Metode:** Jenis penelitian ini adalah distributif dengan pendekatan kuantitatif. Sampel penelitian ini yaitu seluruh keluarga yang terdekat dengan usia 18 tahun keatas yang anggota keluarganya dirawat di ruang ICU sebanyak 30 sampel dengan teknik *Accidental Sampling*. Pengambilan data menggunakan kuesioner Tingkat Kecemasan skala Zung-SARS. Analisis data menggunakan distributif frekuensi. **Hasil :** Tingkat Kecemasan Keluarga yang Dirawat Di Ruang ICU paling tinggi yaitu Tingkat Kecemasan Sedang sebanyak 15 Responden (50%) sedangkan Ringan 9 Responden (30%) dan Berat sebanyak 6 Responden (20%) dan tidak ditemukan Tingkat Kecemasan Panik 0 (0%). **Kesimpulan :** Tingkat kecemasan keluarga pasien yang dirawat di ruang ICU Rumah Sakit Suaka Insan sebesar 50% (15 responden)

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# **DESCRIPTION OF THE LEVEL OF FAMILY ANXIETY OF PATIENTS TREATED IN THE ICU AT THE SUAKA INSAN HOSPITAL BANJARMASIN IN 2024**

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## **ABSTRACT**

**Background:** Anxiety in the families of patient in the ICU needs to be a concern for nurses because this causes poor decision making. The family has an important role in making decisions directly and indirectly in helping, caring for and treating patients. **Objective:** Analyzing the level of family anxiety of patients whose family members are being treated in the ICU at Suaka Insan Hospital. **Method:** This type of research is distributive with a quantitative approach. The sample for this study was the entire closest family aged 18 years and over whose family members were being treated in the ICU, totaling 30 samples using the Accidental Sampling technique. Data were collected using the Zung-SARS Anxiety Level questionnaire. Data analysis uses frequency distributive. **Results:** The highest level of anxiety for families being cared for in the ICU was moderate anxiety level of 15 respondents (50%), while mild anxiety level of 9 respondents (30%) and severe level of 6 respondents (20%) and no level of panic anxiety was found at 0 (0%). **Conclusion:** The anxiety level of families of patients treated in the ICU at Suaka Insan Hospital is 50% (15 respondents)
